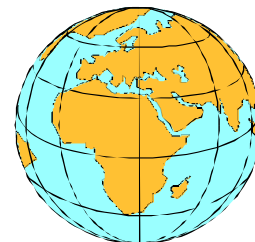

I am delighted to invite you to participate in a conference on "Citizens facing up the European Union". The event will be in the European Parliament under the patronage of Andrew Duff, co-rapporteur on the period of reflection, on Thursday March 30 starting at 9.30 to 16.30, Room A3G3.

This debate - recorded - will become part of a report/book to be made public prior to the May 2006 Conferences on the future of the European Union and the June European Council.
